SUMMARY

In a post-pandemic world, MFD has returned to operations as usual. Our firefighters continue to prove they are ready, capable and adaptable to all situations in the fire service.

In 2023, three members left and seven members were hired. Currently, Minto Fire is at full compliment having thirty firefighters in Harriston and thirty firefighters in Palmerston. Clifford has twenty-four firefighters with one spot open.

Cumulatively, MFD completed 245 incidents with a breakdown of incidents as follows:

- Structure Fires 4%
- No Loss Outdoor Fires 2%
- Medical 30%
- Motor Vehicle Collisions 18%
- Mutual Aid & Assist 8%
- Public Hazard 6%
- Pre-fire Conditions 7%
- False Alarms 17%
- Other 8%

As an organization, MFD continues to advance our service from a technological perspective as we are now majority paperless records for most of our critical processes.

Looking back on 2023, MFD takes pride in our collective achievements. Each day, our management team is grateful for the individual efforts all of our members put forth. We look forward to serving the community in 2024.

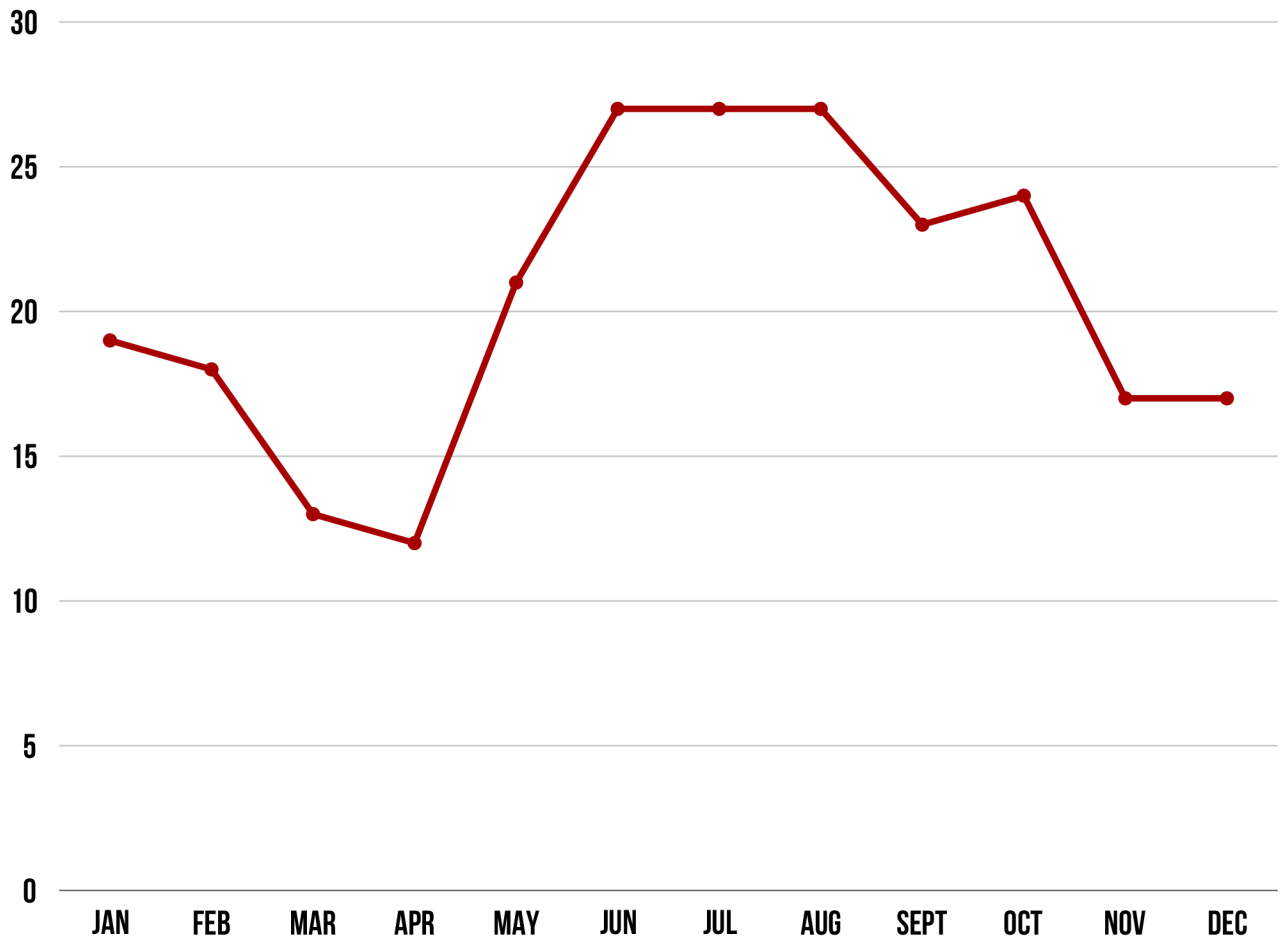

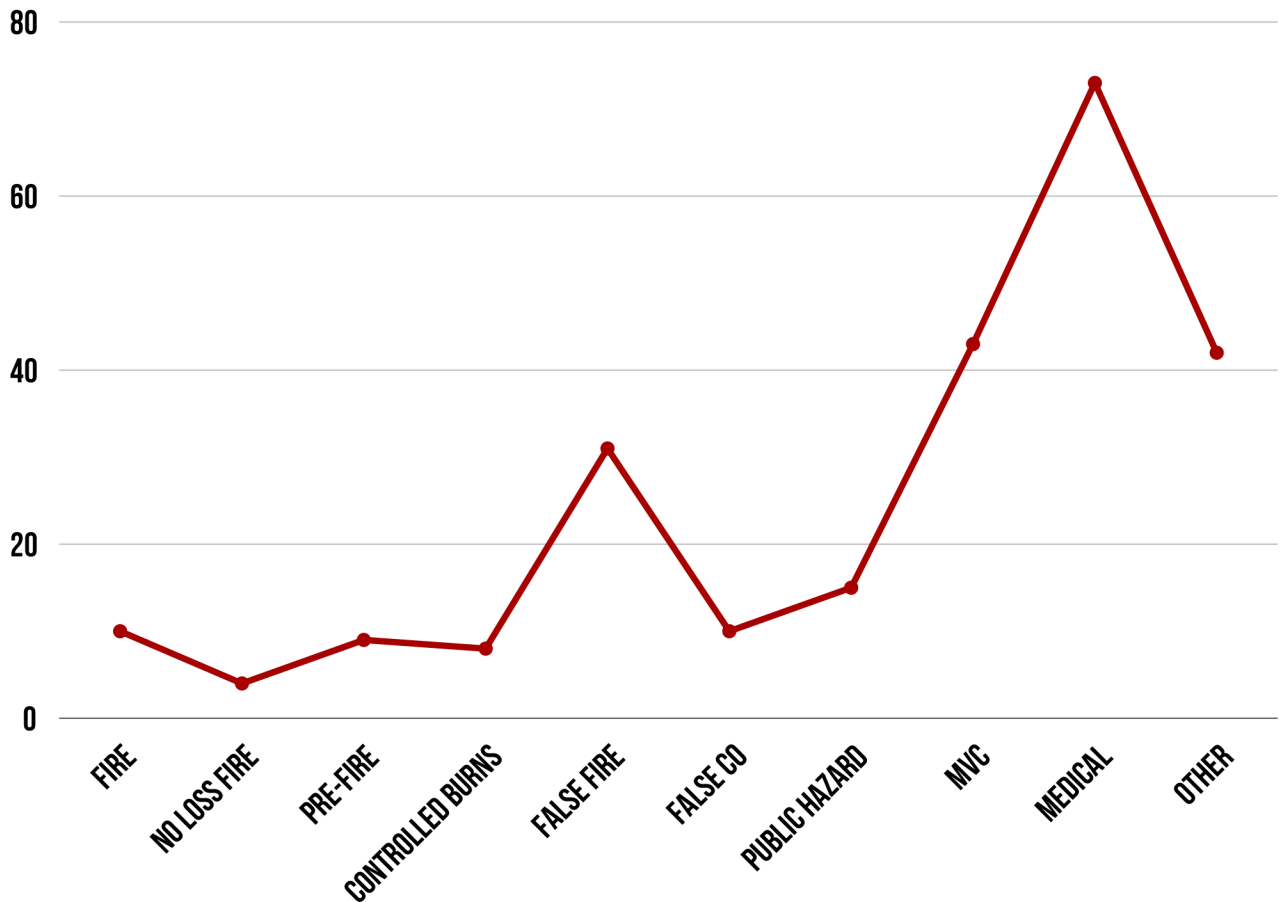
