Chair Turton to state: "Council must decide whether or not to proceed with the project by provisionally adopting the engineer's report by by-law or referring the report back to the engineer for modifications. There is no right to appeal assessments or other aspects of the engineer's report at this meeting; these appeal rights will be made available later in the procedure".
- 9. Clerk McRobb will note a by-law, if appropriate, will be presented during open Council if that is the wish of Council.
