Summary

As of the end of September 2024 our department is operating under budget.

2024 continued to be a very busy year with two department strategic plans completed that will set the stage for our work over the coming years. We wrapped up a successful (awardwinning) Move to Minto Business Attraction campaign that was supported by community partners and RED funding and continued to deliver and/or facilitate a number of community events, workforce initiatives, business development initiatives and marketing and promotion campaigns.

We closed on three industrial properties in the Palmerston Industrial Park to the following businesses:

Float King Manufacturing – 1.7 acres Johnny Garth Wilson – 1 acre 2609861 Ontario Ltd. – 3.83 acres

This leaves one property remaining in Palmerston totaling approximately 3.9 acres.

Uptake on the Community Improvement Plan (CIP) increased from 2023 with several significant structural grants being completed. In 2025 we are proposing to decrease the grant portion to allow us the added funds to update the CIP to come in better alignment with the County of Wellington Invest Well Program, while maintaining the budget related to CIP at \$50,000.

There is a small, proposed increase in the budget in 2025, mostly related to staffing and a decrease in revenues. The focus in 2025 will involve the implementation of the various plans with a continued focus on business attraction and downtown revitalization, diversity, equity and inclusion, workforce development and attraction and housing.
