Service Measures

Grants received from community groups and funding agencies have stabilized over the past two years. We were able to provide swim lessons, swim passes, and day camp programming to children who would not have received them otherwise. We currently work with Canadian Tire Jumpstart, Childrens Foundation, Community Resource Centre, County of Wellington, and Family & Children's Services.

Blessing to You in Palmerston has been a big sponsor of our programming, allowing us to offer them at no charge.

Lottery licenses issued are steady with both local Legions running Catch the Ace events on a regular basis on Thursday and Friday evenings.

There is a large amount of administrative work required to provide the number and types of programs as well as number and types of recreational facilities to the community.
