


BACKGROUND:

Requests for tender were sent out for the Improvement of Municipal Drain 14 under section 78 of the Drainage Act, with the Town receiving 5 bids for the project. The works to be completed are;

- The improvement of approximately 65m of channel.
- Jack & bore crossing of 8th Line.
- The supply & installation of approximately 168m of dual-wall HDPE pipe on wrapped stone bedding.
- Other miscellaneous work as specified.

All bids were received prior to the tender closing deadline and in consultation with the appointed engineer, Streamline Engineering Inc, the three lowest bids were reviewed for mathematical errors or omissions. No errors were found, and we are recommending that Hanna and Hamilton Construction Co. Ltd be awarded the contract.
