### Location

The property subject to the proposed Minor Variance application is legally described as PT LT 8, Herman and Bolton Survey 18-11 Wallace as in RO741761 and is municipally known as 310 York St, Palmerston in the Town of Minto. The subject property is approximately 1,031m2 (11,098 ft²).

## Purpose & Effect

The purpose and effect of this Minor Variance application is to provide relief from the rear yard setback requirement. This relief is requested as a condition of severance application B102/24. Clause 12.2.1.6 of the Town of Minto's Comprehensive Zoning By-law 01-86, as amended, requires a minimum rear yard setback of 7.5 m, whereas 2.5 m is proposed. Additional relief may be considered at this meeting
