To provide for the amendment of Municipal Drain No. 107-2024, Town of Minto By-law 2024-066 and for the collection of the amended assessments

WHEREAS the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the Town of Minto did on the 3rd day of December 2024 passed By-law No.2024-066 to provide for the drainage works known as Municipal Drain No. 107-2024.

AND WHEREAS the actual cost of repair and improvement in accordance with Section 78 of the Drainage Act for Municipal Drain No. 107-2024 before deducting the allowances, amounts to \$10,633.19.

THEREFORE, THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN MINTO, PURSUANT TO THE DRAINAGE ACT R.S.O. 1990, CHAPTER D.17, AS AMENDED, ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. The Treasurer is hereby authorized to amend the assessments made in Schedule "A" of By-law Number 2024-066 to increase the assessments proportionately so that the total amount to be collected under the authority of By-law Number 2024-066 from the lands assessed to Municipal Drain No. 107-2024, will be \$10,633.19 as set out in Schedule "A" attached hereto.
- 2. The assessments as set out in Schedule "A" hereto attached shall be levied and collected from the property as indicated therein and in accordance with applicable Town policies.
- 3. This By-law shall come into force upon the final passing thereof and may be cited as Municipal Drain No. 107-2024 Amendment By-law Number 2025-012.
