**SUBJECT:** PW 2026-019 Pedestrian Crossover Installation Report

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**RECOMMENDATIONS:**

THAT the Council of the Town of Minto hereby receives report PW 2026-019 Pedestrian Crossover Installation Report, prepared by the Roads and Drainage Manager, for information purposes;

AND FURTHER THAT the Council of the Town of Minto directs staff to proceed with the installation of the Level 2 Type B Pedestrian Crossover, as presented, at the intersection of Arthur St W and John St in Harriston;

AND FURTHER THAT the Council of the Town of Minto pass a by-law in Open Session.

**BACKGROUND**

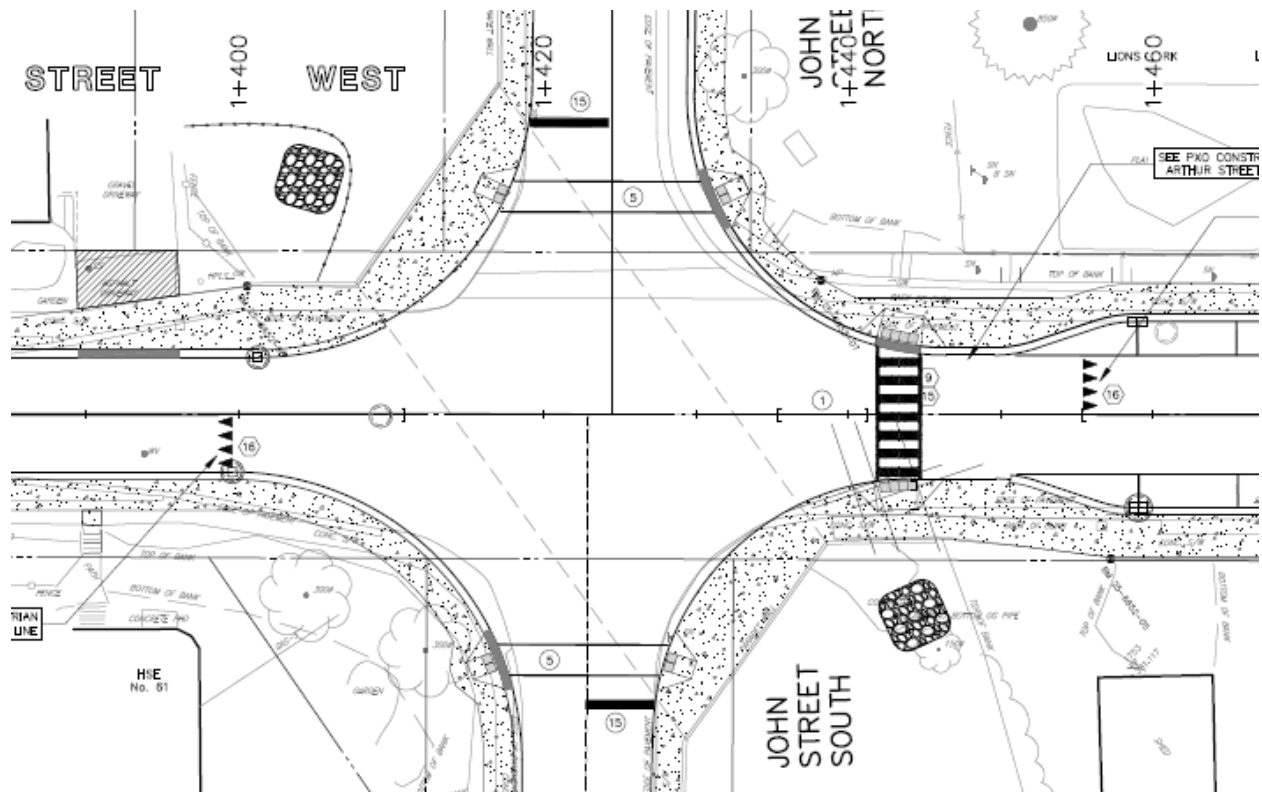
In April 2021, Council received a letter from a group of residents requesting that additional pedestrian crossover locations be reviewed in Harriston, including the intersection of Arthur Street West and John Street.

Triton Engineering previously reviewed this intersection in a letter dated March 5, 2019. At that time, the location did not meet the criteria for a pedestrian crossover. However, the report recommended that the Town continue to monitor pedestrian activity to better understand movement patterns and volumes, and to reassess the need in the future.

Since then, additional monitoring has been completed. Based on this work, staff and consultants have identified this intersection as a key pedestrian route connecting the north and south sides of Harriston. A pedestrian crossover at this location would provide a safer connection, particularly for residents accessing the Lions Medical Centre and Lions Park from the south side of Town.

**COMMENTS:**

The costs associated to the design and installation for a Level 2 Type B Crossover shown below, have been included within the successful application submitted for Arthur St W, Connecting Link Fund. A By-Law has been included for Councils consideration.



**FINANCIAL CONSIDERATION:**

The installation of the Pedestrian Crossover is included within the 2026 Capital Budget, under Arthur St W – C/L
