The Corporation of the Town of Minto By-law 2017-26

to authorize voting by Vote-by-Mail for the 2018 Municipal and School Board Election and to authorize the use of Vote-By-Mail services and vote counting by Personnel

WHEREAS Section 42 of the Municipal Elections Act, S.O. 1996 provides that a municipal council may pass by-laws authorizing the use of voting and vote counting equipment and electors to use an alternative voting method that does not require electors to attend at a voting place in order to vote;

AND WHEREAS Council deems it expedient and necessary to employ Vote by Mail Voting for the 2018 school board and municipal election;

NOW THEREFORE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF MINTO HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. The alternative voting method of "Vote-by-Mail" is hereby authorized for the Municipal Election to be held in 2018;
- 2. A Vote-by-Mail Kit will be provided to every person who qualifies to be an elector. The Kit will either be mailed or directly provided to each qualified elector.
- 3. The Vote-by-Mail Kit shall consist of:
 - a) An outer white envelope;
 - b) A voting instruction sheet;
 - c) A yellow ballot return envelope;
 - d) A voter declaration;
 - e) An inner white secrecy envelope;
 - f) A composite ballot;
 - g) Such other necessary material as the Municipal Clerk determines.
- 4. That the C.A.O. Clerk/Returning Officer is authorized to determine the length of the voting period, including advanced voting.
- 5. That the counting of ballots by election personnel, in keeping with the voting method, is hereby authorized.
- 6. The C.A.O. Clerk is herewith authorized to sign any necessary agreements.
- 7. This By-law shall take effect on the date of final passing thereof.
- 8. By-law 2013-98 is hereby repealed.
