to erect temporary Stop Signs at the Elora St/Mill St E/ Park St W Intersection in Clifford during Reconstruction of Elora Street

WHEREAS Subsection 5 of Section 137 of the Highway Traffic Act, R.S.O. 1990, c. H.8 as amended authorizes the Council of a municipality by by-law provide for the erection of stop signs at intersections on highways under its jurisdiction; and every sign so erected shall comply with the regulations of the Ministry. R.S.O. 1990, c. H.8, s. 137; 2002, c. 17, Schedule F, Table;

AND WHEREAS As part of the Reconstruction of Elora Street, Clifford, the proposed detour route has turning points at Elora St/Park St W/Mill St E., Clifford

AND WHEREAS it is deemed expedient and for public safety that the intersection of Elora St/Mill St E/ Park St W, Clifford has a controlled all-way stop to clarify right-of-way in accordance to the Ontario Traffic Manual.

AND WHEREAS these signs (or a portion thereof) may be removed or added at any time during the course of construction as required;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Minto enacts as follows:

- 1. That an all—way stop sign be erected at the intersection of Elora St/Park St W/Mill St E., Clifford.
- 2. That staff be authorized to realign the stop signs at any time dependant on construction schedules.
- 3. That the signs be in place from May 28, 2018 until the end of the construction contract.
